

# Remembering Black Saturday

Community members turned out in large numbers on Sunday to remember the first anniversary of the Black Saturday bushfires.

About 300 community members, fire fighters and emergency services personnel attended the unveiling of the Bushfire Memorial Wall Mural at Kyneton Town Hall, while community members at Redesdale attended a special service at St Lawrence Church and afterwards at the Redesdale Hall.

In Gisborne, a tree planting and plaque unveiling was held in the Gisborne Lions Park.

The mural is made up of ceramic tiles displaying leaves created from donated porcelain, crockery and china – items which represent a 'home'.
